The Seven Fifty Motor Club invites you to the 46th National Austin Seven Rally Weekend at the National Motor Museum, Beaulieu, Hampshire

Saturday 28th June

Camping on site has now become the tradition for many attending the National Austin Seven Rally at Beaulieu. Cost per unit is just £13 for Saturday night, £16 for a 2 night stay. We invite all those arriving in the area on Saturday, whether camping on site or not, to join us at the 750MC Rally Barbecue, held on the rally site. Food will be served between 7pm - 8.30pm - bring your own booze!
Cost per adult £8, children 15 and under £4.
Accommodation addresses can be obtained from the Tourist Office 01590 689000.

Sunday 29th June

Grounds open at 8am. All departures from the ground by 5.30pm.
The event will feature the optional main Concours, Gymkhana, Austin Autojumble, Bring-'n'-Buy and 750MC book and regalia stand.
There are also classes for Pre-1960 Austin and other Pre-1960 marques. This year we will be focusing on restorations as well as featuring the country's largest Austin Seven autojumble.

The price of tickets still represents a considerable saving over the standard National Motor Museum admission charge of £15.25. Tickets cover admission to the Museum, Abbey and Palace House, but not the Vintage Bus or Monorail.
Valid Saturday 26th June **AND** Sunday 29th June.

The entry fee for car and driver also includes an engraved rally plaque, programme and optional entry to the Concours and Gymkhana.

All passengers and spectators will need tickets to gain admission.
Under 5s are free, children 5 - 15 £3.00.

Visitors can buy tickets in advance at the 'Club rate' by applying to the Rally Secretary.

Rally entry forms must arrive no later than Saturday 14th June. Final details will be mailed out by Saturday 21st June.

Entries received after the closing date will be accepted only at the discretion of the organisers but full price tickets may have to be purchased at the gate. Late entries will not be judged, may not receive an attendance plaque and may be parked in a separate area.

The Rally and Gymkhana are 750 MC A7 Championship point scoring events.

We look forward to welcoming you to the longest running Annual Austin Seven event in the calendar.
