Change Requested:

- 5.12: WHEELS / STEERING
- 1. Permitted Options:

Class A: Wheels must be a maximum of 15" x 7J in size. Class B: Wheels must be a maximum of 17" x 8J in size.

STEERING LOCK: If fitted with a steering lock, this should be rendered inoperative, unless the vehicle is driven to the circuit on the highway. MSA regulation Q19.6.

2. Prohibited Options.

Construction & Materials: Steel or alloy only. Magnesium wheels are prohibited.

- 3. Rose jointed track rod ends may be used on outer ends of steering arms.
- 4. a rack raiser may be used.
- 5. Assist is free but must retain OEM steering rack for model raced

Reason for Change:

Many cars have raced for years with the power steering disabled, whilst the newer generation FN2 Civics have experienced problems with the electric power steering which have led to many drivers fitting GM power steering pumps which technically was not permitted under the original regulations.
