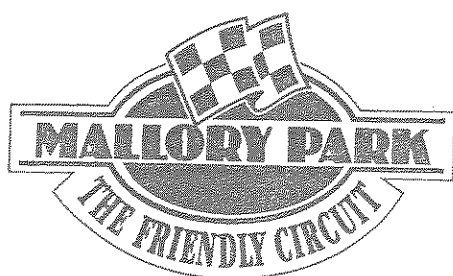

New for 2003 is class C - PRO STOCK - for cars from the Stock Hatch championship running on Yokohama A032R and with very minor changes to induction, exhaust and brakes. Car 21, driven by Tony Scarlett, is entered in both Hot & Stock Hatch today and the only changes Tony has time to make is to switch from the A529 tyre to the A032R. Hopefully the number of cars in Pro Stock will grow to have their own separate race.

Demon Tweaks and Yokohama tyres are the main sponsors for this year's Hot Hatch Championship which attracts a wide range of popular hatchback cars of up to 2000cc. Cars are allowed engine and suspension modifications, standard pattern brakes and all must use the Yokohama A032R 'control' tyre. This together with a weight penalty for leading cars ensures close racing without excessive budgets.

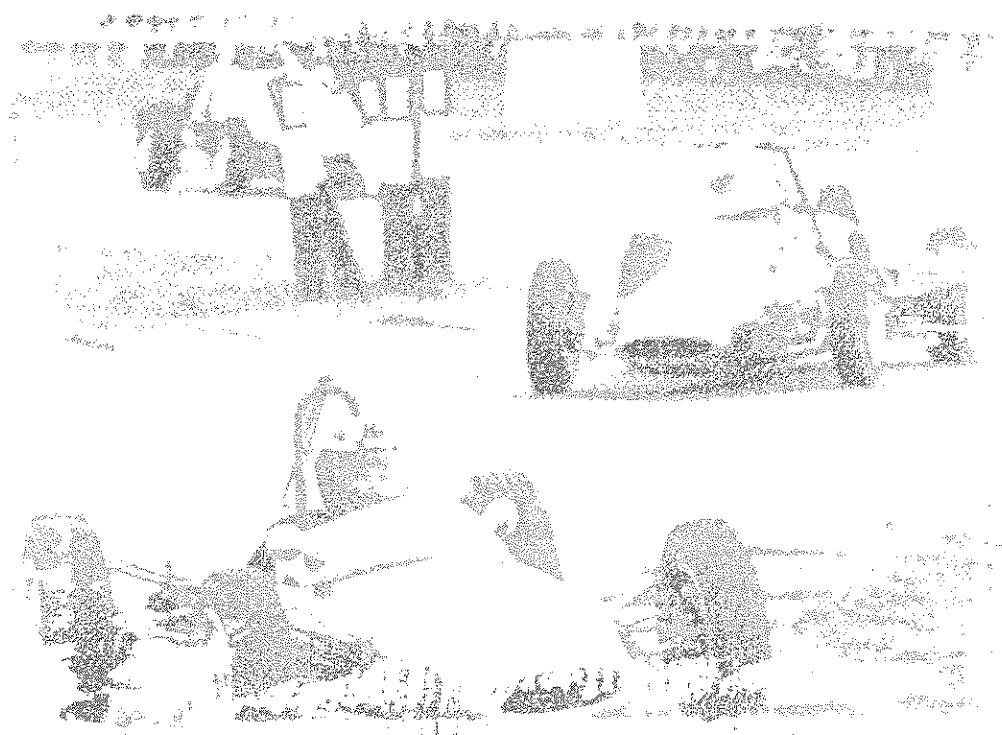

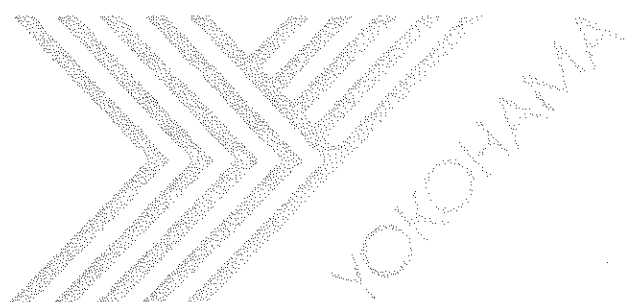

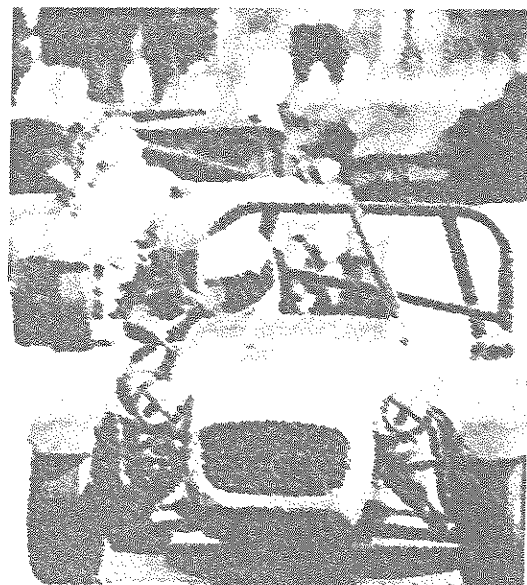

Should the number of qualified drivers reduce to less than 29,  
the two races will be combined as Race 8.



The 750 Motor Club Kit Car Championship is for road legal Kit Cars. The engine regulations allow considerable freedom whilst there are limitations on the design of rear suspension and transmission. There are two classes, A - up to 3500cc and class B - 1800 Ford Zetec.

# Marshalling

As an active alternative to competing, you could become one of the hundreds of hardy souls who clad themselves in orange overalls each weekend, to carry out the variety of jobs essential to the safe running of an event. It's a serious undertaking and can get you very close to the action at times.

Course, Incident, Flag, Observer, Pits, Paddock, Assembly, Race Rescue Unit - all these basically come under the umbrella of marshalling. However, you don't just come along and do whatever job you fancy on the day; there is a lot more to it than that. Those with no experience start as Trainees and will be placed with experienced marshals at whatever position they are allocated. Training days are available, ranging from fire-fighting, incident handling, use and knowledge of the many flags through to, after years of experience, becoming Examining Observer or Specialist.

The 750 Motor Club looks after its Marshals, realising only too well that they are all volunteers and it has a Sponsorship Scheme to assist new marshals to buy the necessary kit (overalls, wet weather gear etc) or to help with their replacement; this funding uniquely comes directly from the 750 Motor Club competitors by way of donations to our Marshals Fund.

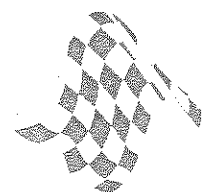
