If it's a sportscar produced in a reasonable volume, it's probably eligible - there is no more varied a Championship for sportscars in the UK and its split into separate classes based generally on engine capacity/car type. Engine must be original fitment, but crank, rods, pistons, camshaft, induction and exhaust are free; head mods are permitted; add-on forced induction is not permitted. Power outputs will vary between 100bhp in the small class, to getting on for 350+bhp in the big V8s. Transmission must be a production-car gearbox. Close-ratio gears and LSD are permitted, traction control is not.

Sevens first raced in 1923. Bill Boddy kicked off the Seven Fifty Motor Club in 1939 and the first Austin 7 race (Formula 750) took place at Silverstone in 1950. Raceworthy components became scarce and Austin 7 racing declined during the late 1970's. The **Austin 7 Triple Challenge** is held in celebration of those pioneering days. Austin 7 racers from all eras are once again on the track displaying the traditional spirit of friendly, but resolute, competition. Handicap results are calculated after the finish by applying a performance-related allowance to each car.

First introduced in 2001, this Championship is for two-seater cars which must be capable of passing an MOT. Cars may be constructed specifically for the series or may be one of the many motorcycle engined cars currently available. The engines must be series-production four-stroke units and may not be modified from standard; they run in three classes; standard Fireblade engined kit cars (class C), up to 145 bhp (class B), 146 to 180 bhp and all rear-engined cars (class A). Control tyre is the Yokohama AO48R.

Group C: Road going cars, with limited engine and bodywork modifications, all running Bridgestone tyres on 5" wide rims.
