750 Formula is for two-seater sports racing cars, introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits. There are two engine options, either the highly tuned Reliant 850cc or the unmodified Fiat 'FIRE' 1108cc, the latter introduced in 2003 due to the diminishing supply of spares for the Reliant engine. All cars run on a control Yokohama slick tyre.

Austin Centenary Display & Parade

On behalf of the 750 Motor Club, I welcome Austin members and guests to this major weekend of Club racing at the home of British Motor Racing. Please take time to see some of the racing – mostly 15 minute races for Austin Seven, sports cars, kit cars, Locost, Hot Hatch, Stock Hatch (the most popular championship in the world), Formula Vee and F4.

We especially welcome John Coleman and the 1925 Austin Seven with which he drove a marathon journey from Buenos Aires to New York in 1959. The adventure is the subject of his book, 'Coleman's Drive'. (John will have copies of this book for sale on the club stand - a really good read).

Also present are 5 of the 6 Austin Sevens and their crews, that completed the first 1,400 miles, of that fabulous drive in Jan/Feb - to kick off this *Austin Centenary* year. All 6 cars completed the 3000 mile round trip – including climbing to 10,000 metres across the Andes to Peru – with no major mechanical problems!

The 750 Motor Club is proud of the fact that it has been in existence for nearly two thirds of the century of the *Austin*, having been formed by a group of Austin Seven owners in 1939, the last year of Austin Seven production. The inaugural run was on the 16th of April of that year. Membership grew in the post war years to around 3,000. Many members became interested in competition and, in 1949, the '750 Formula' was devised by Holland Birkett. It was a racing formula for Austin Seven sports and specials with strict limits on tuning and modifications to keep costs down and reliability up. Many famous race drivers/constructors like Colin Chapman, Eric Broadley of Lola, Jem Marsh of Speedex and later Marcos and Tony Southgate, designer of the LeMans winning Jaguars and Audis cut their teeth in the 750 Formula.

By 1962 some members were realising the historic value of the Austin Seven and the Austin Seven Register was formed within the club. In 1963 the first National Austin Seven Rally was held at Beaulieu with 200 cars. About the same number attended this year's 43rd rally. Other events include shows, local social runs and foreign rallies.

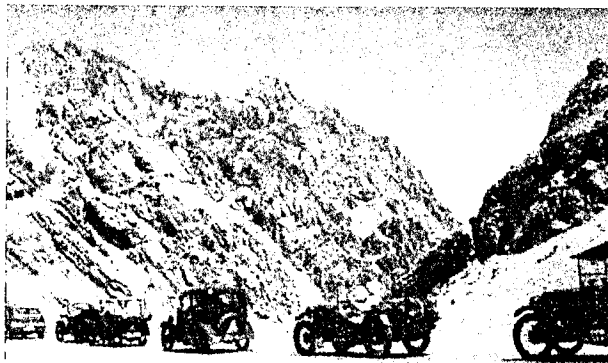

In 1964, with Austin Seven engines becoming more unreliable under racing conditions the Reliant engine was introduced in the 750 Formula and a couple of years ago the small Fiat unit replaced that - but the formula is still going strong. Over the past 50 years many more formulae have been introduced for the amateur club racer as you can see today.

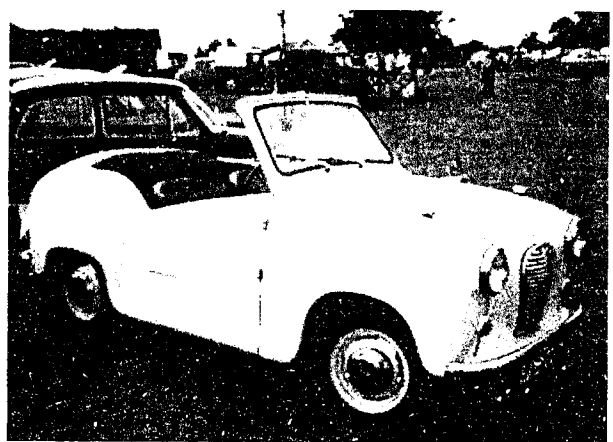
In 1996 Ron Champion wrote a book about a sports car he built for £250 which he called the 'Locost'. The club has since successfully adopted the design for one of its race formula.

Power outputs will vary between 100bhp in the small class, to getting on for 350+bhp in the big V8s. Transmission must be a production-car gearbox. Close-ratio gears and LSD are permitted, traction control is not.


