The Lenham Cars MG Midget

Challenge is run by the MGCC and was started in 1977.

Eligible cars include all models of MG Midget and Austin Healey Sprite, plus the 'historic' bodied versions such as Ashley, Lenham, Sebring, Speedwell and WSM.

The championship is split into 3 classes, with varying amounts of modifications.

Group A: Fully modified cars running on slicks up to 10" width.

Group B: Race modified cars running with standard shape bodywork and slicks up to 6" width.

Group C: Road going cars, with limited engine and bodywork modifications, all running Bridgestone tyres on 5" wide rims.

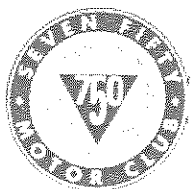

Premier Choice Group 750 Formula Championship

750 Formula is for two-seater sports racing cars, introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits. There are two engine options, either the highly tuned Reliant 850cc or the unmodified Fiat 'FIRE' 1108cc, the latter introduced in 2003 due to the diminishing supply of spares for the Reliant engine. All cars run on a control Yokohama slick tyre.

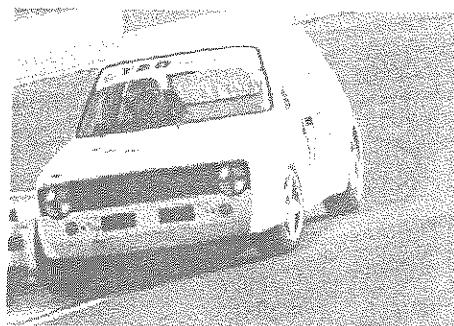

In August last year a group of VW Golf enthusiasts (Adam Stevenson, John Hillon, Andy Walker and Phil Bowler) started talking to the 750 Motor Club about running a series of races for the VW Golf GTi Mk2. Skeleton regulations were drafted and amended several times along the way, but the result is obvious here today that the series has great potential. The supply of cars and spares is plentiful, as a standard vehicle it has good handling & performance, it is relatively 'bullet-proof', so it is an ideal car for a low cost one make series. All cars run on Toyo tyres, have a Newman control camshaft in otherwise standard engines and have minimum weights for the two classes (8v & 16v).
