Class B is for FF2000 cars built prior to October 1983, class C for pre Dec '80, running to the former FF2000 regulations and Class D, sponsored by **microshop**, sees pre 1999 Formula Ford Zetec cars.

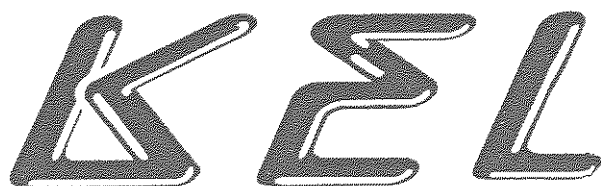

New for 2001, the 750 Motor Club series for Roadgoing bike-engined cars is for two-seater cars which must be road legal and capable of passing an MOT. Cars may be constructed specifically for the series or may be one of the many motorcycle engined cars currently available from a wide range of kit car manufacturers. The engines must be series-production four-stroke units and may not be modified from standard; they run in two classes according to the manufacturer's figures, of up to 135 bhp (class B) and of 136 to 180 bhp (class A). The series is supported in its inaugural year by FISHER SPORTSCARS.

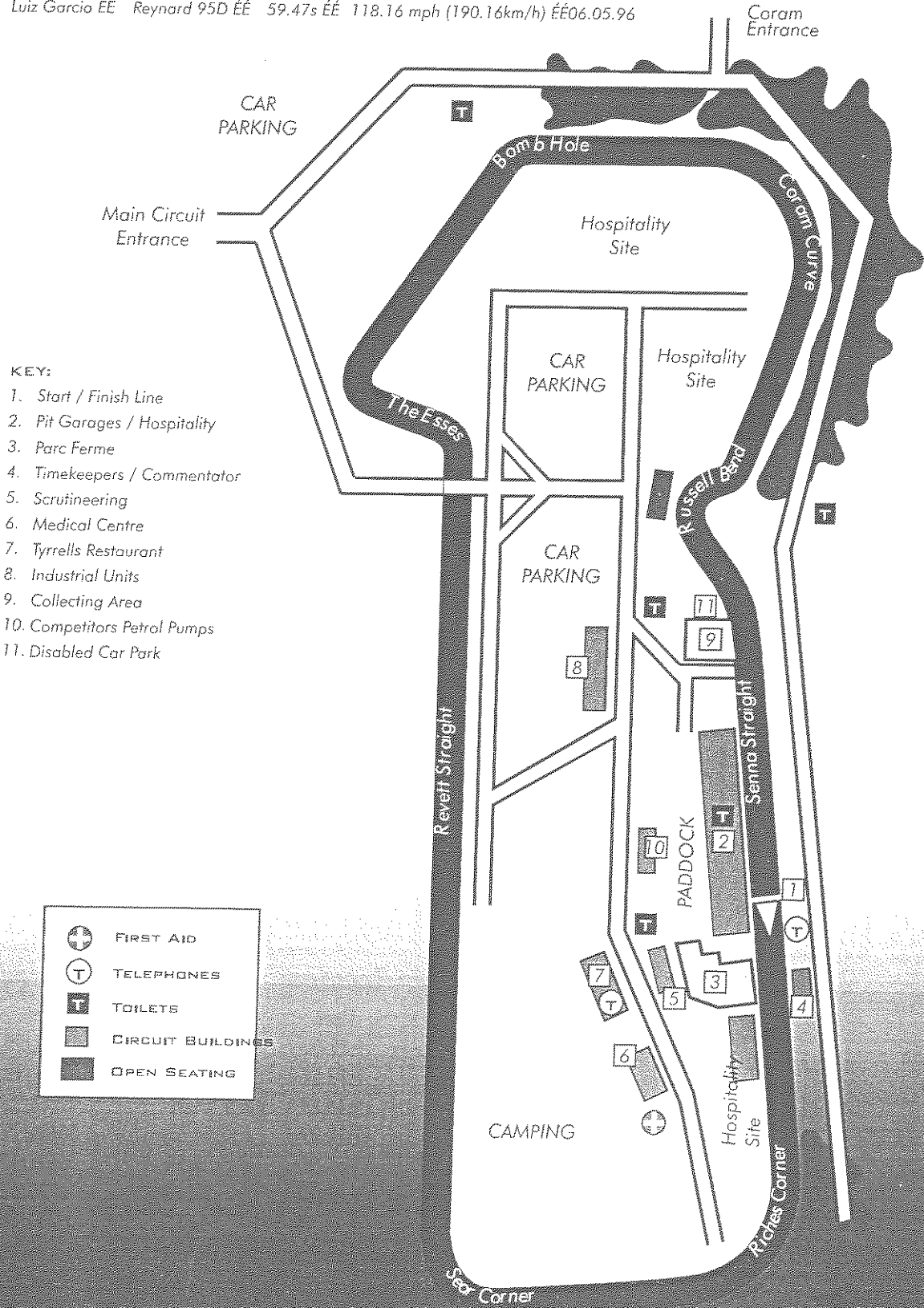


