MEETING PREVIEW | by Josh Barrett

Oulton Park kicks off a busy few weeks to conclude the 750 Motor Club's 2021 season with three championship final meetings over four days of racing within an eight-day period - plus the annual Birkett Relay in two weeks' time.

Five championships conclude today on the Oulton Park International Circuit. The Rymax Lubricants Sports 1000 Championship will begin the day's action for motorcycle-powered sports prototypes with the category's first appearance on the full length layout in over a decade. Ryan Yarrow has already wrapped up the title after winning six of the ten races contested in his self-adapted Spire GT3. Michael Roots, currently on three wins, heads a tight battle for the runner-up spot. Mittell team-mate Victor Neumann looks for his first win in the category, while longstanding competitor Colin Chapman and Rich Miles (one-time winner) are also in contention.

For the first time in the history of the category, a Mk3 Roadster looks set to take the honours in the hotly contested Toyo Tires Toyota MR2 Championship, which boasts a capacity grid today. Reigning champion Aaron Cooke is hoping to hold on to his crown, with a fourth-place finish enough to clinch it. He has taken seven victories over the course of this season, while title rival and multiple former champion Shaun Traynor comes to the weekend on five. Class B champion Cam Walton will also be looking to add to his first overall victory at Castle Combe.

A strong grid for the Hitek Electronic Materials Alfa Romeo Championship looks set for a couple of interesting races with champion Barry McMahon electing to sit this weekend out, meaning there will be a new overall race winner this weekend. Power Trophy champion George Osborne has been the runner-up six times to McMahon this season in his Alfa 75, so would love an overall win but has often been involved in close battles with class rival Tom Hill in his newer GT. Gareth Haywood has been rapid in his Modified-class GTV so may prove hard to beat if luck is on his side, while the spectacular 4.7-litre Giulietta of Roger Evans should be quick, which runs in the Invitational class. The Twin Spark Cup is always entertaining - Richard Ford has already clinched the 2021 title, but brother James Ford, Jonathan Billingsley and Andrew Bourke have also been winners this season in the category for 156 and 147 models.

James Harridge is hoping to claim back-to-back championships in the Heritage Parts Centre Formula Vee Championship with a fourth-place finish set to be enough for the Maverick racer. His closest rival is the 2008 champion Daniel Hands in an AHS Dominator, while also in contention is 2018 champ Craig Pollard in a Bears GAC. They have taken five, three and two wins respectively this season with some incredible battles on track.

Finally, a 40+ car grid for the Tegiwa Club Enduro Championship will be in action for a 125-minute race for production saloon and sports cars. The Seat Leon of Rob Baker and Carl Swift has only been beaten once this season and therefore their overall title score can only be equalled this weekend by class C racers John Langridge and Alex Miller with their Mazda MX5. The Class B battle is however the one to watch, with four cars still in contention. Defending champion Luke Handley (Volkswagen Golf) leads the way but is closely followed by Phil Dryburgh (Porsche Boxster), William Stacey (Lotus Elise) and Will Beech / Mark Grice (Volkswagen Golf).

Whether you are trackside or following along on the Alpha Live livestream, there is plenty to look forward to for the 750 Motor Club's second visit of the season to the Cheshire venue.

BLUE/STEADY

Another competitor is close.

BLUE/WAVED

Another competitor is trying to pass.

WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

YELLOW(WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

YELLOW(DOUBLEWAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking.

YELLOW/RED.STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.

GREEN

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap.

RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by Marshals (at startline & individual Marshal's posts). Race Stopped.

BLACK/ORANGE.DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to driver that his behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of Course.

GET INVOLVED AT THE SHARP END OF MOTORSPORT

As an active alternative to competing, you could become one of the hundreds of hardy souls who clad themselves in orange overalls each weekend, to carry out the variety of jobs essential to the safe running of an event. It's a serious undertaking and can get you very close to the action at times - writes Peter Harding

Course, Incident, Flag, Post Chief, Pits, Paddock, Assembly, Telephone, Race Rescue Unit etc. - all these basically come under the umbrella of marshaling. However, you don't just come along and do whatever job you fancy on the day; there is a lot more to it than that. Those with no experience start as Trainees and will be placed with experienced marshals at whatever position they are allocated. Training days are available, ranging from fire-fighting, incident handling, use and knowledge of the many flags through to, after years of experience, becoming Examining Post Chief or Specialist.

The 750 Motor Club looks after its Marshals, realising only too well that they are all volunteers and

it has a Sponsorship Scheme to assist new marshals to buy the necessary kit (overalls, wet weather gear etc) or to help with their replacement; this funding uniquely comes directly from the 750 Motor Club competitors by way of donations to our Marshals Fund.

With its many race days the 750 Motor Club has lots to offer to both new and experienced Marshals.
