After 26 days on track for 750 Motor Club plus another ten away-days at guest events, the Club's main 2022 season rounds out here at Mallory Park, with five formulae in action including two with championship titles yet to be decided.

This year the Demon Tweeks | Yokohama Classic Stock Hatch Championship is set to be settled in a Mallory finale between longstanding racer Pete Morgan – bringing the Fiesta XR2 model back to the sharp end of the grid – and Chris Dear, in his Peugeot 205 GTi. There is little to separate the pair in the points tally, however Dear does hold a greater advantage going in to this weekend's two races once the mandatory drop scores are taken into account.

In the FreakyParts Sport Specials Championship, it will be Stuart Thompson who takes home not just the Class B but overall championship title, following an impressive season in his MK Indy RR. In Class A however the title can still go the way of both Westfield driver Lewis Ward on his debut year in the formula, and multiple defending champion Andy Hiley, depending on how this Sunday's races pan out. The same is true in Class C for MEV machinery, where former Formula Vee driver Dave Hughes is set to go head-to-head with Stewart Mutch for class honours, whilst all four of the above will technically be vying for the runner-up spot in the overall championship table.

Craig Pollard secured the title in the Martins Group Formula Vee Championship this season with a meeting to spare; the Suffolkbased driver adding a second crown to his previous 2018 championship win – this time in the ex-Graham Gant WEV machine. The battle is on for the remaining positions in the top six in particular; protagonist Danny Hands heads up a close battle between Vaughn Jones, Andrew Cooper and Tim Probert, whilst James Huckle and Matt Topham are vying for the Class B top spot.

Darvi 88P driver Peter Bove added another impressive title to his tally in the Raceparts 750 Formula Championship; taking his third in a row in impressive style with a meeting to spare; and the second time he's managed a back-to-back trio in his extensive championship history. There's little to separate Richard Rothery (PRS 1b) and Olly Collett (Racekits Falcon) behind though, whilst four drivers are within a mathematical chance of securing the Class B championship win.

Finally, Mallory Park is always a firm favourite venue for the Raceparts Historic 750 Formula Series; which can be suitably proven by a capacity grid entry here on an October weekend. It is a delight to see the ever-growing Austin Sevens of Class A match entry numbers in Class C for the first time in the recent era, and that's not including Tim Roebuck and Simon Gallon's Austins in Class AS. Matthew Edwards brings one of the rare Wragg Specials out for the second time this season, whilst look out also for the Mallock U2 of Tim Sage in Class C.

750 Motor Club heads to Silverstone in two weeks for the Birkett Six-Hour Relay, but will return to Mallory Park once more this year, running the 2022 Plum Pudding race meeting here on Boxing Day.

Cars are divided into two classes based on power to weight ratio, at 340bhp/tonne (Class A) and 270bhp/tonne (Class B). All cars must be 2WD and naturally aspirated. A third class also runs solely for MEV Exocet R kit car models.



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

FLAG SIGNALS

BLUE/STEADY Another competitor is close.

BLUE/WAVED

Another competitor is trying to pass.

WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

YELLOW(WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

YELLOW(DOUBLEWAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking.

YELLOW/RED.STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.

GREEN

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap.

RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by Marshals (at startline & individual Marshal's posts). Race Stopped.

BLACK/ORANGE.DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to driver that his behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of Course.
