MEETING

PRFVIFW

This year marks 73 years since the 'VSCC Bentleys' and a lineup of Jaguar XK120s claimed the inaugural 'Handicap' and 'Scratch' race victories respectively, in a novel six-hour team motorsport event. In the years to come the race would become known simply as 'The Birkett' in honour of its original architect (and 750 Motor Club founding member) Holland 'Holly' Birkett.

Often seen as the traditional end to the club racing season – and described as the last bastion of British motorsport – it is an event like no other and steeped in history, yet one legendary race in which any circuit racer can compete. The winners Roll of Honour might include names such as Graham Hill and Gerry Marshall, however the list of other notable alumni includes everyone from Jim Clark to Steve McQueen and Chris Rea.

Taking place once again at its modern era home on Silverstone's full Grand Prix Circuit, we're set to see another capacity field of 70 feams and nearly 300 cars and drivers looking to chase both the outright 'Scratch' win and coveted 'Handicap' honours.

This year there are three teams who look a likely bet to vie for Scratch trophies; primarily behind the wheel of machinery from Radical Sportscars; the Peterborough-based manufacturer that originally grew out of the 750 Motor Club paddock. John MacLeod will be aiming for a record sixth Birkett win here this weekend in defending scratch winning team 'RSR' alongside Ben Stone and James Lay. MacLeod currently shares the five victory tally for the most Birkett wins with Doug Newman; the Caterham racer who excelled in an ever-changing 'Goldarts' team lineup in the late nineties and early noughties, but also Chevron racer Alan Eisner.

On the subject of Chevron success; a team of B8s, B6s and B16s claimed the Scratch victory without Eisner in 1986, but did have one familiar name in the lineup. That was 1992 BTCC champion and broadcaster Tim Harvey, who returns to the Birkett in 2024 for the first time in 37 years, but this time behind the wheel of something at the other end of the race car spectrum. Another Scratch victory might be a bit of a long shot even for this Carrera Cup champion, but along with team-mates Scott & Ryan Parkin, Dan Silvester and Adam Blair, the 'Swift Sport Challenge' team will have their eyes fixed firmly on the Handicap crown.

The Swifts don't house the only recognisable names on the entry list this year. Representing the BMW Car Club Racing Championship, 'Team BMW' sees CCR regular Paul Laramy partnered with BMW touring car star Adam Morgan and four-time BTCC champion Colin Turkington, all behind the wheel of 'Cup' cars from the most approachable class within this one-make club championship.

Elsewhere and following on from a hugely successful season for the series that donates its profits to charity CALM; we are set to see a massive turnout of all-Porsche teams; 47 years since 2024 series title sponsor Charles Ivey himself won the Birkett Scratch race.

Look out for the 'Tea Cups'; a lineup of the feisty Hayabusa-powered Cup 200 cars which were scintillatingly quick at the 2023 Birkett and best of the rest behind the Radicals to finish fourth on Scratch; this year featuring drivers Richard Webb, David Watson, John Cutmore and Mike Whiteman-Haywood. They'll be up against a usual heady mix of mostly Caterham-based teams of Seven-esque machinery; from the two Boss Racing outfits ('Boss Cats' and 'Boss Birketteers'), three teams from fellow Caterham specialists McMillan Motorsport, plus 'London Gentleman Racers' and 'Six Sevens'.

We can't look at the kit-car type entries without the annual doff o'the cap to 'Run Baby Run'; this outfit derived from 750MC Sport Specials Championship racers almost an omnipresent fixture in the programme in the modern era; this year with five different models of UK home-grown sportscars from Anton Landon's Cyana Mk2 to Paul Collingwood's Eclipse SM1.

That variety in machinery has always been a key feature of the Birkett; and as well as the aforementioned we have everything from 2RacingUK's Mazda2 hatchbacks and the Cogswell brothers' Nissan Almera GTi, to Tom Walpole's KTM X-Bow GT4, Matthew Brennan's Mk2 Escort, Alex Child's Alfa GT Junior - not forgetting Ian Cooper's Daewoo Nexia in the RAF Motorsports team.

As far as variety goes within one team though, it's hard to see past cunningly-titled 'Suffolk N'Fast'; who are set to field not just two Sports 2000 cars, but also two ASCARs, a Chevy NASCAR and what else but a Plymouth Barracuda to ensure that the soundtrack of this Saturday at Silverstone is set to shine. Finally, taking the honour of best team name for the second year in succession, look out for Darlington & District Motor Club's mixed medley of tin-tops in 'Run DDMC'.





FLAG SIGNALS

BLUE/STEADY

Another competitor is close.

BLUE/WAVED

Another competitor is trying to pass.

WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

YELLOW(WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

YELLOW(DOUBLEWAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking.

YELLOW/RED.STRIPES

Slipperv surface ahead.

GREEN

All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap.

RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by Marshals (at startline & individual Marshal's posts). Race Stopped.

BLACK/ORANGE.DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to driver that his behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of Course.

BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED

End of the race
