Donington GP CIRCUIT – OFFICIAL BULLETIN

Access / Sign-On:

Access to the paddock will be from 13:00 on Sunday the 4th April.

Signing On needs to be done electronically in advance of the meeting, please refer to the event Final Instructions for full details on completing the signing on process.

Please only bring Essential helpers to the meeting due to the current conditions. Spectating is not permitted, and spectator areas will not be open.

Paddock Parking:

Competitors have been allocated a large area of space in the main paddock (please see Final Instructions for diagram.) There are no vehicle passes but due to the size of the entry, competitors must NOT bring non-essential support vehicles into the paddock. **As per the latest Motorsport UK guidelines face coverings MUST be worn at all times in the pit garages, pit lane, pit wall and assembly area**

Scrutineering / Drivers Briefing:

Scrutineering will be done in advance of the meeting by means of an electronic self-declaration which is part of the meeting sign on process.

Race Numbers:

As a result of a few duplicated race numbers, we have prefixed a few drivers race number with a "1" please check the online race programme and final instructions to check if this impacts you, we will have number "1's" available free of charge for these drivers in Race Administration.

Qualifying:

Qualifying will commence at 10:20 and be a 20-minute session, for teams with two drivers, both drivers must complete a minimum of 3 laps in this session. Irrespective of category/class, cars will be gridded in order of qualifying times.

Race Start:

The race is at 14.00, it will be a rolling start and there will be a green flag lap.

Pitstops:

After 15 minutes a "PIT OPEN" board will be displayed at the start finish line, this will be shown for 3 laps.



After this teams will be permitted to make their mandatory stop and driver change (if required.) All cars must be stationary for a minimum of **90** seconds, the additional 30 seconds of the previous standard pit stop length is to allow extra time for the sanitization of common touch areas of the vehicle when changing driver.

ALL pit crew must wear face coverings (full face helmets and/or balaclavas are permitted) during ANY pit stops.

In the CALM All Porsche Trophy category, the fastest cars in each class will have to spend an extra amount of time in the pit based on their lap time during qualifying (the organisers will apply a datum lap time if the qualifying time is not representative of the car / driver combination's potential.) Each competitor will be advised of the extra 'handicap' time following qualifying.

Timing of the pitstop is the responsibility of each team and will be scrutinised by the judges of fact in the pitlane and the timekeepers.

The pitlane speed limit will be 60 km/h (38mph)

After 30 minutes a "PIT CLOSED" board will be displayed.

Cars not stopping for the required duration, or making their only pit stop outside of this time period will receive a time penalty. If short stopping the judges of fact regarding pitstops will apply a penalty of the balance of the mandatory pitstop time x 2, plus an additional 30 seconds.

Engines may remain on during the pitstop.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded to all class winners, however due to Covid-19 restrictions there will be no prize giving ceremony.

Leaving:

Competitors must vacate the paddock by 21:00 hours.
