



Croft – AFRC Bulletin

Access / Sign-On:

Access time to the paddock is available all weekend, details in event Final Instructions. Signing On needs to be done electronically in advance of the meeting, please refer to the event Final Instructions for full details on completing the signing on process.

Paddock:

The Final Instructions show a shared paddock area with MR2 Championship. AFRC Sat, MR2 Sun. The AFRC hospitality unit provided by Paul Sheard Autos will park at the end of the AFRC allocated area and serve as a datum for constructing the military branded paddock space. Military awnings must be grouped together by Service in any order. Space is allocated for one trailer / van behind each awning to store equipment and anchor the shelters. None military guest entries are to paddock beyond the military awnings

Championship Livery:

Championship livery packs were distributed at Silverstone, anyone not at Silverstone or requiring additional vinyl are to speak to Chris Slator or the co-ordinator. Vinyl for championship competitors is to be applied in accordance with the 2022 Decal Layout available on the 750MC website prior to any official session.

Cameras:

It is mandatory to carry a forward facing camera for all competitive sessions within AFRC. The championship has a number of loan cameras available, please ask Chris Slator for access to a loan camera which will need charging overnight prior to the event. Camera to be fitted prior to scrutineering.

Scrutineering:

Scrutineering is required for those cars which weren't present at Silverstone or had remedial work to complete.

Hospitality:

Due to the low entry numbers for this event at the deadline for ordering catering there will be **no catering provision**, however tea/coffee will be provided in the hospitality area.

Briefing:

There is no mandatory briefing at Croft.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded in the AFRC hospitality unit after Race 2.
