CIVIC PARADE

To commemorate the start of the Civic's 50th year of manufacture and to mark the recent closure of Honda's Swindon plant – where they were made - there will be parade of Civics before the first race. This will require all competitors in the Type R Trophy and Civic Cup, together with chosen cars from the show, to perform four laps behind the safety car before forming up on the grid. Further details will be provided in the Final Instructions.

With many of the Covid restrictions lifted, there are no restrictions placed on ticket sales or spectator movement. Therefore, weather permitting, we're expecting a good crowd.

Please note that because of the way the show is laid out, the race paddock actually forms part of it, so please keep your area clean, tidy, safe and secure.

ARRIVAL & PADDOCK ACCESS

All race teams will be located in the outer paddock. Your parking area will indicated on a plan provided with the final instructions.

Access to the paddock will be from 15.00 on Saturday 25th.

Wristbands will be issued to enable pit lane access for team personnel only and to keep out unauthorised personnel.



TICKETS & PASSES

Four tickets will be emailed to each team using the MSV system next week. Please look out for these and because they are sent from a bulk email system, please check your junk folder.
