Passes: Access to the venue and restricted paddock areas is by the issued wristband or Motorsport UK officials licence/registration card.

Venue Access: Access to the venue and paddock areas will be from 08:00 Friday 25th June 2021.

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series without wasting space. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused.

Signing On for Competitors: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Scrutineering: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Drivers Briefings: All drivers must read the Drivers' briefing notes in advance of the event.

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable.

Circuit Access: Access to the Circuit will be as follows; PF*fc* and FCRS – will join the circuit directly from the Pitlane

DDMC NSSCC and Alfa Romeo – will use the Assembly Area and join the circuit at Turn 1, Clervaux.

All cars may be noise tested in compliance with Motorsport UK General Regulation J.5.17-18 prior to being released onto the circuit. Drivers should be ready 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the circuit.

Stop/Go & Drive Through Penalties: The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to impose a 'Stop/Go Penalty / Drive Through penalty' in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation [Q 12.26].

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down and enter the Pitlane following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Fermé area as required.

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Race Starts / Grids: Prior to each race, cars will be released from the Assembly Area / Pitlane to complete a lap of the circuit and form up on the grid in the positions specified on the published grid sheet. The countdown will then commence at the 1 minute signal followed by a further formation lap before a standing / rolling start in accordance with the relevant Championship / Series regulations.

PFfc, DDMC NSSCC and Alfa Romeo will use a Standing Start FCRS will use a Rolling Start

The grid for the 2nd DDMC NSSCC race will be determined by the competitors 2nd fastest qualifying time. Grids for all other races will be determined in accordance with the relevant published Championship/Series regulations.

Live Snatch: Live snatch recovery operations under a local Yellow Flag may be undertaken at Turn 1 (Clervaux) at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Official Notice Board / Information: The organisers will try to run the programme as published, but they reserve the right to delay or bring forward event times to suit the conditions of the day. Copies of practice times & results will be published online at www.tsl-timing.com
