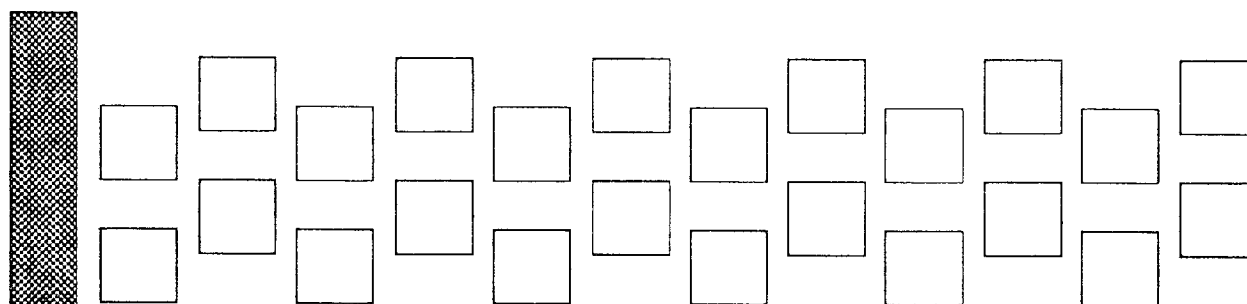
The Club organises approximately ten Championship rounds each season, and points scored count towards end-of-year trophies.

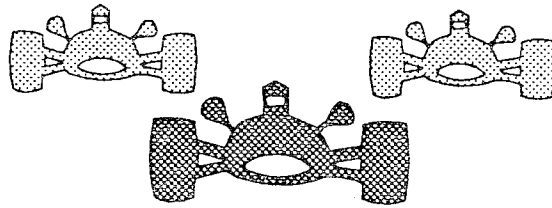

MARSHALLING



Today's meeting is organised by the 750 Motor Club, with all the officials being motor racing enthusiasts who participate in their spare time.

Many of you will have noticed groups of people at certain points around the circuit. These are the MARSHALS. Marshals play an important role at every race meeting - they ensure that the drivers can race safely and spectators can watch safely.

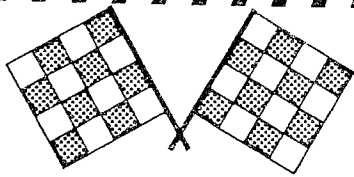
An Observer, who is an experienced Marshal, is in charge of each Marshals post. He is responsible for reporting all incidents to the Clerk of the Course.

Flag Marshals are responsible for giving warnings to the drivers, using flags. The yellow flag also provides any Marshal who may be dealing with an incident on the circuit some 'protection'.

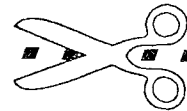
Fire and Course marshals have to do the real 'dirty' work. They must deal with every incident quickly and safely.

At every race meeting there will be at least one Race Rescue Unit. The Rescue Crew is trained to use specialized cutting and lifting equipment to release drivers who are trapped in cars, especially injured drivers.

All Marshals are UNPAID volunteers, who give a lot of time and effort to Motor Racing. If you are interested in Marshalling, please fill in and return the coupon below.
