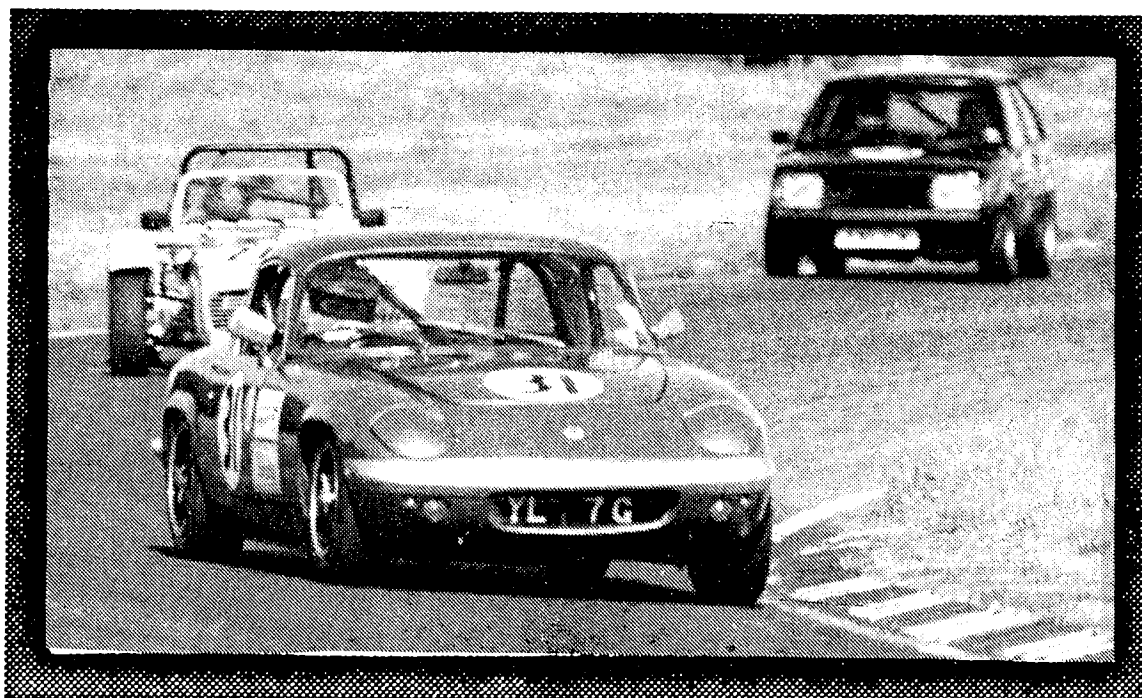

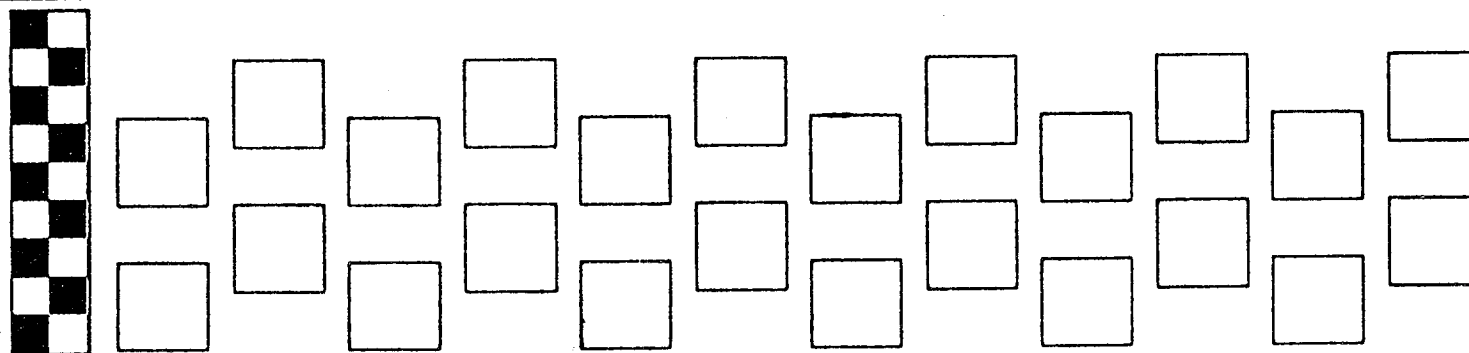
Once again, the formula receives sponsorship from Volkspares, which is paid to competitors on finishing positions. Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall.

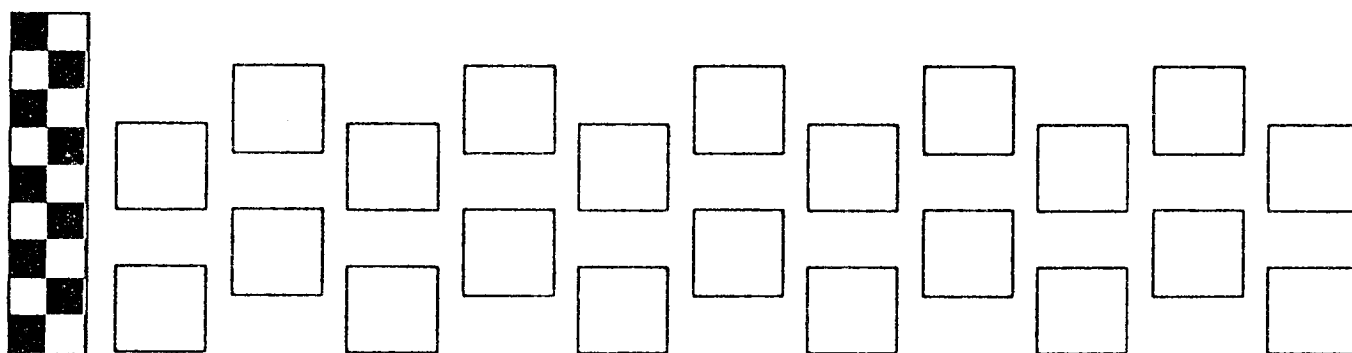

Formula 4, which was taken over by the 750 Motor Club in 1970, is for single-seater cars with no restrictions on chassis design; class B permits pre-October 1983 FF2000 cars (or pre-October 1982 Reynard) run to FF2000 regulations. Engines are either Ford Crossflow 1300, 1600 CVH or Hillman Imp. There are about 12 Championship rounds per season, run at circuits throughout the UK.

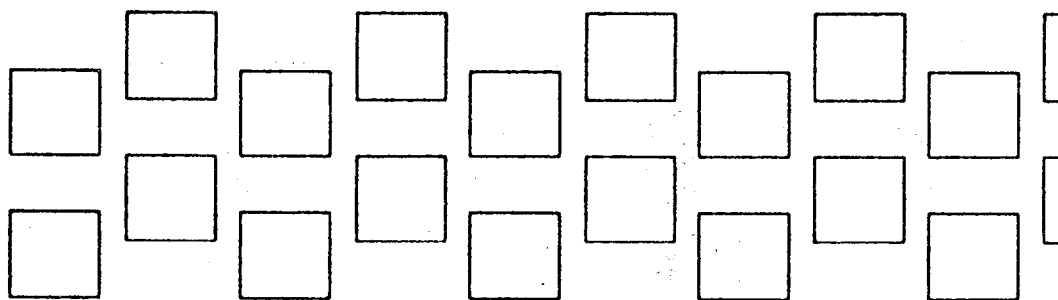

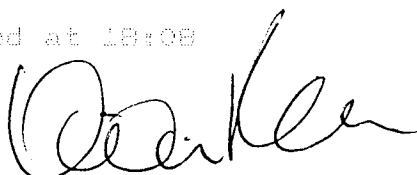
