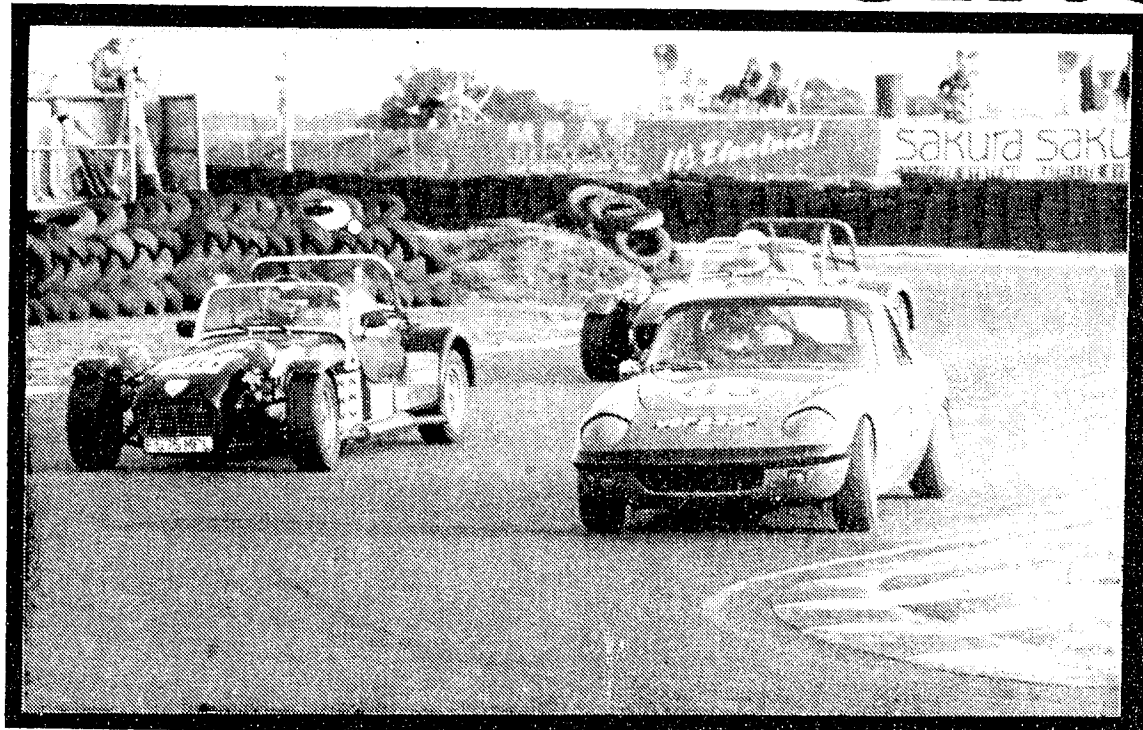

Formula 1300 is for two-seater sports-racing cars, formulated by the 750 Motor Club in 1953, and originally used the Ford 1172 cc side-valve engine. The cars now use either the Ford 1300 crossflow or the 1600 CVH engine, both types with tuning restrictions. The chassis may be either home-constructed or proprietary front-engined (i.e. Mallock) at least two years old. There are about 15 Championship rounds per season.

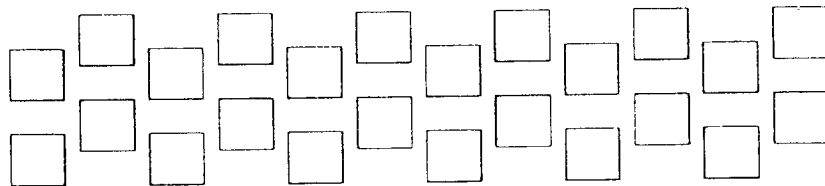
Once again, the formula receives sponsorship from Volkspares, which is paid to competitors on finishing positions. Awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall.

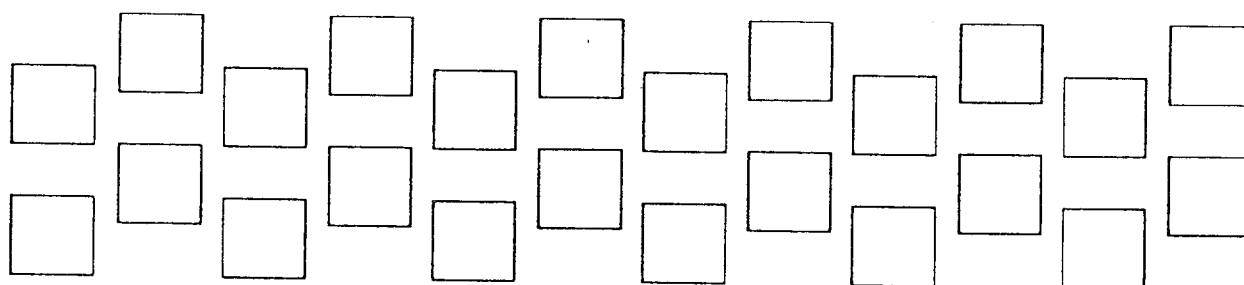

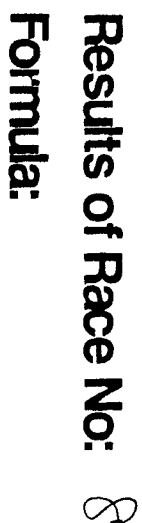
