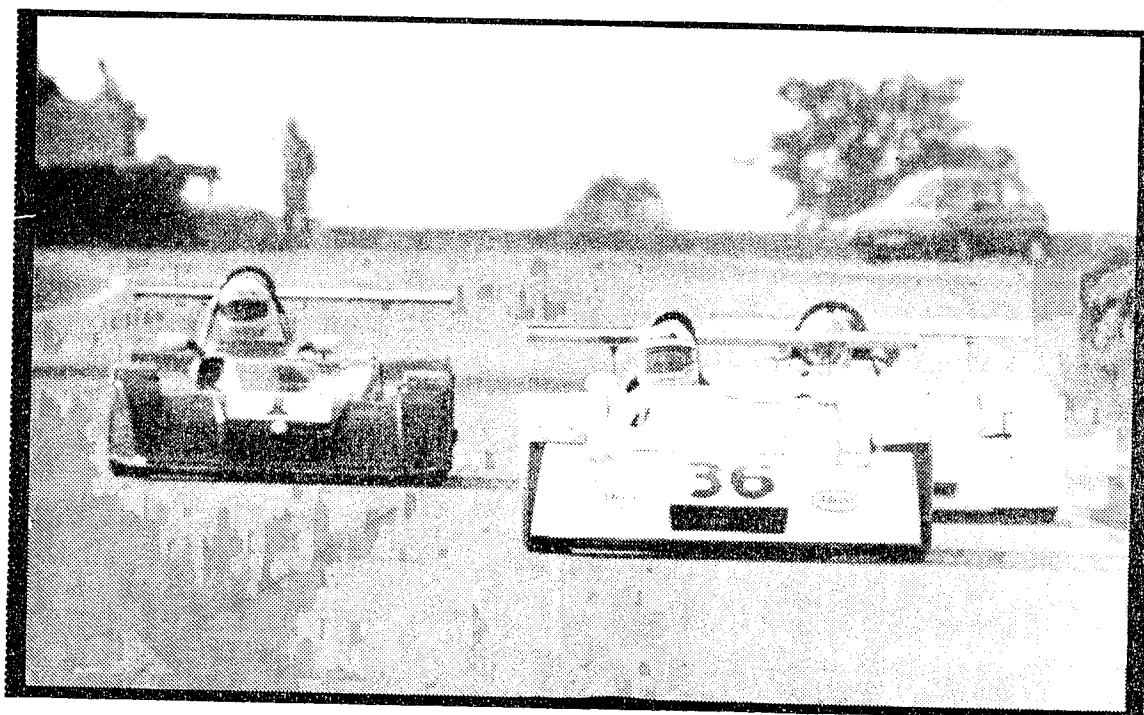

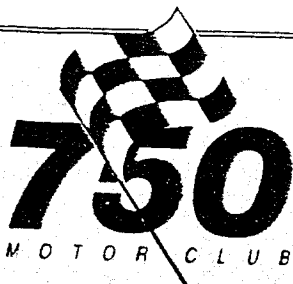

DRIVERS COMPETING IN MORE THAN ONE EVENT MUST SIGN-ON FOR EACH ONE. THOSE WHOSE PRACTICE AND RACE ARE NOT ON THE SAME DAY MUST SIGN-ON ON BOTH DAYS.

COMPETITION NUMBERS WILL BE FOR SALE AT SIGNING-ON OFFICE.

SCRUTINEERING: Remember to take your fire-proof overalls and helmet with you to scrutineering. Cars which are presented excessively early may be asked to wait until their allocated time.

PLEASE REPORT TO CLERK OF COURSE BEFORE YOUR PRACTICE SESSION

PRACTICE SESSIONS: Drivers for the first session should ensure that they are in the assembly area in good time. Following sessions should go to the assembly area when the practice session prior to theirs has started (or when called for on the tannoy). Please display your scrutineering pass on your vehicle.

DRIVERS BRIEFING: 1.30 Sat; 12.45 Sun.
Compulsory for ALL drivers, in Scrutineering Bay. Bring your completed form with you and hand it in after the briefing. Failure to attend could result in exclusion from the meeting and/or a £50 fine.

RACE GRID ASSEMBLY: When called for, drivers should take their cars to the assembly area. They will then be marshalled onto the circuit and should complete one lap, when they will be arranged in correct grid order on the startline. On the green flag, all cars will complete one warming-up lap in grid formation round to the startline, where they will again take up their correct positions. Practice starts and excessive weaving are prohibited during this warming-up lap.

START PROCEDURE: This will be in accordance with the Supplementary Regulations. No car may leave the grid without permission, unless on the specific instructions of an RACMSA scrutineer. Any car leaking oil or fuel onto the circuit will be removed from the grid (or black-flagged if during the race). There is no penalty for push starts.

FINISH PROCEDURE: After the chequered flag is shown on the start/finish line, cars will leave the circuit via the exit road to the paddock. Outright and Class winners should stop by the startline after completing one slowing down lap.

NOISE LEVELS: Competitors are reminded that noise meter readings will be taken during the meeting. Any vehicle exceeding the limits set by the RACMSA 1992 Blue Book cannot be permitted to take part in the event.

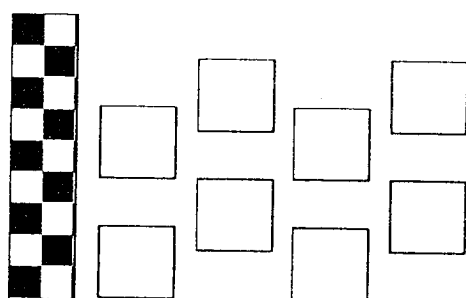

Formula 4, which was taken over by the 750 Motor Club in 1970, is for single-seater cars with no restrictions on chassis design; class B permits pre-October 1983 FF2000 cars (or pre-October 1982 Reynard) run to FF2000 regulations. Engines are either Ford Crossflow 1300, 1600 CVH or Hillman Imp. There are about 12 Championship rounds per season, run at circuits throughout the UK..

The Formula enjoys new support this year from Motorsport Engineering Services of Warwick, who specialize in race preparation and maintenance, modifications and conversions, fabrication and repair, and design of components. Cars can be run on a 'one-off' basis and help can be given with testing and development.
