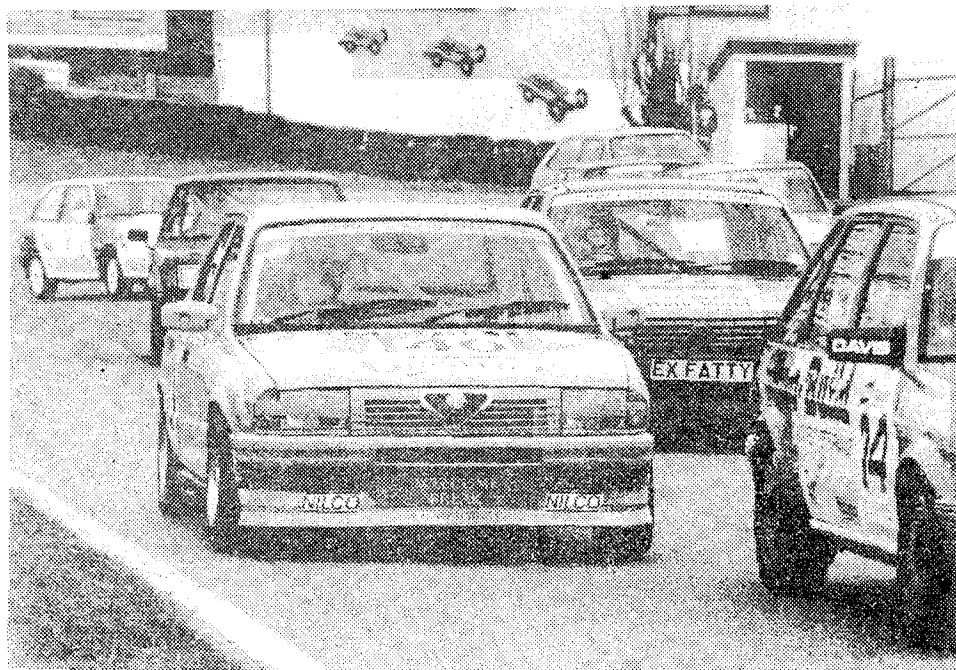

The KIT CAR CHAMPIONSHIP, running with the support of DAX (DJ Sportscars) of Harlow and the LASER Motor Company of Epping is for genuine roadgoing kit cars as recognised by the Club. Cars must be front-engined, run on road tyres and have a current MoT. Run in three engine-capacity classes of up to 1350ccs, 1351 to 1660ccs and 1661 to 3528ccs maximum, all engines must be genuine production engines and tuning is quite limited. Many of the cars are also used by their owners on the road and this is an ideal formula for the driver who wants to construct his own vehicle from a proven design.

The HOT HATCH CHAMPIONSHIP (race 2 over page) is new for 1993 and has two main sponsors - MARSHAL TYRES and FAST CAR MAGAZINE. The regulations allow any listed Hatchback car available for sale in the UK three or more years ago, up to a maximum of 1600 ccs, with a class split at 1400ccs. Multi-valved engines up to 1400 ccs go into the 'big' class. Minor engine modifications & suspension tuning is permitted and, apart from safety regulations, are identical to road cars. MoT is required and all cars run on a MARSHAL 767 tyre. Close and entertaining racing is guaranteed from this new 'low cost' formula.

750 FORMULA is the Club's original racing formula, introduced in 1949 for two-seater sports-racing cars built round the Austin 7 chassis and mechanicals. Virtually all were built and designed by the driver but it was not long before Colin Chapman started building and selling cars for racing in this formula.

In 1966 the regulations changed to permit the more reliable Reliant engine to be used; the engine size is now 850ccs and performance is controlled by a carburettor restrictor. Wings and slicks are permitted and the designs continue to be innovatory and technically advanced.

This is the fifth round of the 1993 Cox & Buckles TR Register Championship for Triumph TR Sports Cars.

The Championship enjoys financial support from Cox & Buckles Spares, a division of Moss Europe Ltd., who are the leading TR spares manufacturers and suppliers, and also from a number of Associate Sponsors who are connected with the TR marque.

There are ten rounds covering most British circuits. Points are scored on an 8,6,4,2 basis within the classes dependent on the number of starters in each class. An extra point is scored for fastest lap in each class. The best eight scores count towards the Championship.

FORMULA 1300 was introduced by the Club in 1954 as being the 'big-brother' to 750 Formula and is for two-seater sports-racing cars. Many cars are home designed and built, others being proprietary front or rear engined cars. Over the years various engines have been used and this season sees the Ford crossflow 1300 and CVH 1600, whilst Sports 2000 and Clubmans B cars are permitted running to their own regulations. The high standard of preparation of these cars is equalled by the competitive yet friendly spirit of the drivers.

The SUPERSPORTS CHAMPIONSHIP once again enjoys support from NEWWEY'S JEWELLERY CENTRE of BIRMINGHAM and is for more modified kit cars. Rear engined cars are eligible, but cars must still for this year run on road tyres. This year sees some changes to the regulations, with racing gearboxes and multi-valved engines being introduced; next year tyres will be slicks. The engine capacity classes are:- up to 1350ccs 2 valves, up to 1660ccs 2 valves, 1661-2100 2 valves and up to 1450ccs multi-valve, and the 'big' class is 2101 - 4076cc 2 valves and up to 2100ccs multi-valve.

FORMULA 4, the Club's 'slicks and wings' single-seater formula, caters for the amateur designer/constructor in Class A where there are no chassis restrictions and engines are either the Ford 1300 crossflow or the 1600CVH; some cars are converted F3 or FF1600/FF2000 others are highly successful designs by the driver himself. Class B permits pre 1982 FF2000 cars run to those regulations. The combination provides very close racing, demands technical skill in preparation and setting-up and yet is still available within budgets lower than those usually expected for this type of racing.

ROADGOING SPORTSCAR Championship is probably the Club's most popular formula, catering for genuine production sports cars (as approved by the Club). Engine modifications are free within controlled limits, alterations to suspension and braking systems are permitted, tyres must be road legal and all cars must have a current MoT certificate. There are 4 classes:- up to 1330ccs; 1331 to 2500; 2501 and over; and a separate class for all Lotus 7 and Caterham 7 cars. A very wide range of cars always provides entertaining racing.

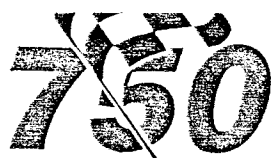

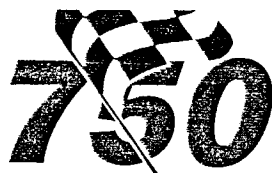

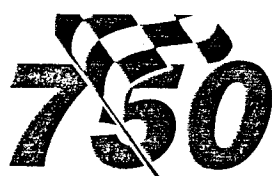
