MG R-Type sells for £126,000.00.

To the observer of historic race cars, the 'R' Type M.G has a unique, jewel-like quality, truly a Grand Prix car in miniature. Only ten of these Marshall-blown racers were ever constructed and when it was revealed on the 25th April 1935, it caused gasps of admiration the world over as its construction was on the cutting edge of the day's technology.

Chassis No: 0255 was bought by the successful 'Bellvue Garage' - whose name is now synonymous with the M.G. marque - and they entrusted the preparation to their young and talented in-house tuning specialist, 'Wilkie' Wilkinson, ('Wilkie' was to later become the driving force behind 'Ecurie Ecosse' but his talents were first formed with the MG marque at 'Bellvue Garage'). '0255' was debuted in the May 1935 Brooklands JCC International Trophy with Doreen Evans behind the wheel. Her tenacious driving brought her home 7th o/a and second in class, immediately behind the MG 'R' Type of Sir Malcom Campbell, at an average of 80.63 mph. Further success with '0255' followed before Doreen heard the sound of Wedding Bells at the end of the 1936 season, when she forsook motor racing and sold the car to ERA driver, Roy Hesketh, who took the car back to his homeland South Africa. '0255' was campaigned hard in native S.A Grand Prix racing until the outbreak of WW2. Hesketh laid-up his successful M.G and dutifully took up service in the Air Force - never to return. '0255' did not re-surface until 1948, when it was sold off to local club racers. By 1963 it was languishing in a Bullawayo scrapyard from where it was rescued by Ralph Clarke who nurtured '0255' back to life



over a period of 37 years.

H&H CLASSIC AUCTIONS sold the re-patriated car to an English collector for £126,000.00 in July 2000 at Buxton.

SEBRING RACER SELLS FOR £89,250

The 1964 Austin Healey Factory Race Team car '767 KNX' was sold at nearly £30,000 over its lower estimate by **H&H CLASSIC AUCTIONS LTD** at their sale on 14th February 2001. This impressively original car was driven in the 1964 Sebring 12-Hours race by Paddy Hopkirk and Grant Clark. It later competed in the gruelling 1966 and '68 Targa Florio road races in the hands of Ted Worswick - who drove '767 KNX' to and from both of these historic






He was absolutely right. The three races of the 2000 season were a roaring success, so much so that Top Hat is back again for 2001, sponsored again by H&H Classic Auctions and Classic Cars magazine, and now bigger and better, with an even more exciting variety of cars and drivers than before. A large grid means there's plenty of room for all of the saloon car racing favourites from the Fifties and Sixties: Mk2 Jags, Lotus Cortinas, Ford Mustangs and Mini Coopers.

They'll all be battling for honours. But one of the best features of Top Hat is the tremendous variety of cars that Julius manages to find; from an Austin A30 to a Mercedes 'Fintail' saloon, if it's interesting and unusual, and eligible for some form of historic saloon car racing, then it's welcome on the Top Hat grid.

This year's Top Hat action starts here at Donington Park. At 3.25pm on Sunday, 34 of the most varied historic saloons ever to compete for tarmac space will thunder away from the starting grid and all dive into Redgate corner. Unmissable.

'Cloth Cap' 50s and 60s Sportscars

Can you imagine what it must have been like to stand among the politely cheering spectators at Donington Park or Le Mans, or any other great circuit for that matter, in the Fifties or Sixties? The sight of the greatest, the most beautiful and usually the most oddball sports cars built during the golden era of sports car manufacture pitting their makers' reputations - and quite often finances - against each other was thrilling stuff.





Well this weekend, the Top Hat one-hour endurance race for Fifties and Sixties sports cars will bring the colourful excitement of those great battles back to Donington Park. This new sports car series was inspired by the success of the Top Hat series of historic saloon car races that ran its first full series last year, and instantly gained the nickname Cloth Cap, after Sunbeam Harrington racer Clive Harrington asked Top Hat saloon series organiser Julius Thurgood why there wasn't a similar series for sports cars.

Variety is the most important ingredient in the Cloth Cap ethos, and alongside the quick and beautiful Jaguars and MGs you'll find oddities with fascinating history, such as Clive's Sunbeam Harrington, which his father built to race at Le Mans in 1961, and other oddities with unknown history, like the MGA Monza Coupé driven by Peter Stock. It will be interesting to see how this dark horse does on the day.

Everyone will have their own favourites to support, but Classic Cars magazine will be shamelessly cheering on our own International Editor, Robert Coucher, who will be sharing a drive with Adam Richardson in his Porsche 356 Roadster GT. Robert will have a lot to think about come race day. As well as grappling with 33 other Derek Bell wannabes on the track, he will have to find a few moments to scribble down the cut and thrust of the experience for a full feature to appear in the July issue of Classic Cars.

The H&H Classic Auctions race weekend promises a rich and varied programme of racing action, and the Top Hat Sports car race, at 3.10pm on Saturday, looks like being one of the most exciting. Which car will you be cheering for?

FIA Lurani Trophy for Formula Junior cars

Formula Junior was the most International Formula of all times, from 1958 to 1963, gradually replacing the 1½ litre F2 and the motorcycle engined 500cc F3 cars as the stepping stone to Formula 1. It was the brainchild of Italian Count "Johnny" Lurani and provided for 1.0 or 1.1 litre production engines, and gearboxes in mini Grand Prix chassis. In its short 6 years, the design span covered the major progression of racing car evolution from ladder frame front engined cars, through space frame cars with proprietary suspension like the Alexis HF1, rear engined spaceframes such as the Coopers, to the full monocoque of the Lotus 27. Jim Clark, John Surtees, Mike Spence and Lorenzo Bandini were amongst the G.P. Stars who formulated their careers in F.J. Races were run from Estonia to Australia, Macao to Cuba, with hundreds of cars competing regularly across USA and East and Western Europe.

In 1975, Formula Junior was the first past formula to be revived as an historic series by the Monoposto Register, and the Formula Junior Historic Racing Association ("FJHRA") was established in 1993 (and can be contacted through FJHRA secretary, Duncan Rabagliati, on fax 020 8946 2367 or email: rabagliati@cableinet.co.uk).

In 1995, at the inspiration of German F.A. delegate, and Lola FJ owner, Joos Tollemaar, the FIA Lurani Trophy for F.J. cars became the first FIA Championship to be run by its own organisation.

For the Lurani Trophy - the three categories for Historic Formula Junior:-

FJ/1-F pre 1961 front engined



FJ/1-R pre 1961 rear engined

FJ/2 post 1960 front and rear engined

score points equally for each race, whilst F3/500cc cars may run in this Championship as an invitation category only.

After Donington Park, championship races will be run at Monza (I), Most (CZ), Zolder (B), Nurburgring (D), Mondello Park (IRL) and Dijon (FR); the 67 drivers who scored points in the 2000 Championship came from 13 different countries across Europe, Australia and USA.

Today's race is wide open with many new drivers and cars. At the front we can expect a battle royal between Y2000 Monaco Formula Junior winner Denis Welch (Merlyn Mk5), ERA and Alta exponent, Martin Walford (Lotus 22) and TGP runner Michael Schryver in his newly acquired Lotus 22 run by Simon Hadfield - but strong opposition will also come from the newly imported Lotus 27 of Mike Hibberd, and Scottish surgeon, Hugh Chalmers in his red Lotus 22, while GT40 driver, Allen Lloyd in the ex Tony Thompson 27, and Austin Healey exponent Bruce Montgomery (Lotus 20) in their recently acquired cars will no doubt be showing their experience too. Dark horse could be Miller's Oils



representation, Robin Longdon in his Lotus MK5.

In the early mid engined class, where the cars all have drum brakes and wet sump engines, 71 year old ex motorcyclist David Stevenson's Cooper T56 will be the car to beat, but former FISA historic champion Phoebe Rolt, now living in France, has not lost her skills either, while enthusiastic Italian Marco Antonucci in his red De Sanctis will be up there too, unless he springs a surprise and arrives with a new Brabham BT6 or Wainer in the FJ2 class, as he has had his shopping basket out recently!!


In the classic front engined class, it will take some beating to see Tony Steele other than in first place, but the other Lola Mk2s of German Dietrich Merkel and Britain's David Pratley will be chasing hard, as will the familiar orange Alexis of series organiser, Duncan Rabagliati - however, Grant Wilson (Gemini Mk 2) and banker, Crispin Besley's red Elva 100, are likely to be the other two strong runners, should Tony falter.



Morgan Motor Company Ltd Challenge

The Morgan Motor Company Challenge began in its present form in 1990, since when it has been proud to have had the support of the Morgan Motor Co Ltd., manufacturers of this great British sports car. The championship is open to all road-going, 4-wheeled Morgans and is divided into five classes encompassing both standard and modified cars. Class A is fully modified Plus 8 cars up to 4600ccs. Class B is Plus 8 up to 3999cc, Plus 4 and 4/4 up to 2350ccs;. Class C is standard Plus 8 up to 3999ccs;. Class D is Plus 8 up to 3600ccs;. Class E is production 4 cylinder Morgans. Points are awarded for finishing position in each class, plus fastest race lap, thus ensuring equal opportunity for the overall championship winner to come from any of the classes, although the race winner will undoubtedly be from class A.




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The 750 Motor Club

Founded in 1939, the Seven Fifty Motor Club which is at the very heart of amateur motorsport in the UK and continues to expand its activities, now runs no less than 12 racing formulae at most major circuits, mud plugging winter sporting trials (September to May) and has over two dozen regional centres that organise road runs, rallies and club nights.
